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

NVR 2015. Well the National VET Regulations 2015 will be in effect by July and we will be working under a new regulatory framework again! While there are some changes for all Registered Training Organisations (RTOs): Designers and Developers alike must now incorporate into their activities a raft of new requirements. The changes affecting Enterprise RTO's are at least, less onerous.

Streamline Packages. Many organisations are being affected by the transition of Industry Training Packages to the new streamline format. The new TAE for Work Place Trainers and Assessors is one package to review and understand the implications to training organisations in particular.

AVIO8. The Aviation and Logistics Industry Skills Council is still to release the new streamline Aviation Package AVIO8 in line with the new standards. It will be with interest that we see how the new requirements for TAE and the CASA regulatory framework will be integrated into the new package, particularly for flying instructors.




